

***PANIC NATION*, A FILM ABOUT THE CONTROVERSIAL ISSUE OF STATE-SPONSORED IMMIGRATION LAWS, WINS BEST DOC AWARD AND RECOGNITION BY THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES**

Panic Nation premieres to an enthusiastic audience and wins the **Best Documentary Award** at the Broadway International Film Festival in Los Angeles. In addition, the film's Producer/Director **George Adams**, is recognized by the City of Los Angeles and awarded a **Certificate of Celebration** for his contribution to cinema, art and culture.

"We are absolutely thrilled about winning here in Los Angeles.", says the Producer/Director. "The film speaks to the humanity of this emotional issue."

Former White House cabinet member **Henry Cisneros**, two-time Harvard graduate, syndicated columnist and CNN contributor **Ruben Navarrette Jr.**, multi-award winning writer of "Sesame Street" **Luis Santeiro**, and multi-award winning actor **Esai Morales** are among of the interviewees. Citizens, professionals, business owners and experts tell their stories inter-woven with those of lawmakers like Oklahoma's State Representative **Randy Terrill**, who fashioned America's first state omnibus immigration law and pre-cursor to Arizona's SB-1070.
