

Here is a brief update on the progress of *Panic Nation*, a feature length documentary motion picture about the effects that state immigration laws are having on our state and country.

We have submitted our documentary to the International Documentary Association (IDA) for financial sponsorship. If accepted, we will be able to apply for various grants, financial aid and donations under a non-profit 501 status. We are awaiting their decision and have people waiting in the wings to donate once the IDA grants approval.. I'm fairly certain we will be accepted due to my association with *Torn from the Flag*, which enjoyed a successful participation with the IDA.

Our list of potential interviewees grows larger each day. We currently have a list of over 105 potential interviewees. These people range from various state and federal representatives from Congress and the Senate to local business owners and people directly affected by the state immigration laws as well as prominent celebrities from the Hispanic community.
